

HOMEBOUND SERVICES AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS

Homebound instruction is available to students who are confined for periods that would prevent normal school attendance based upon certification of need by a licensed physician or licensed clinical psychologist. Eligibility is determined by local school personnel on the basis of information submitted. If a student has been identified as disabled, the student's Individual Educational Program (IEP) shall be revised to reflect the delivery of home-based services. Elementary School students should receive a minimum of five hours of home-based instruction per week. Middle School students should receive a minimum of eight hours of homebound instruction per week. High School Students should receive two hours per core academic subject per week; other accommodations on an individualized basis. If appropriate to the needs of the child, the number of instructional hours may vary.
